TOPIC: Fall Events Update

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Community and Library Services Commission receive an update from staff regarding the Fall Events including Ohana Day, the Bay Front Festival and Run, Unity Day, Trunk or Treat (TOT) and PUMPKATAAZ.

BACKGROUND:

OHANA DAY

The Hercules Senior Center holds an annual Ohana Day, that features a program specific themed lunch, and a special performance by the Aloha Hula Class.

This year the Ohana Day event will be held at the Hercules Senior Center on Monday, October 6, from 12:30-3:00pm. A Hawaiian themed lunch will be served to all participants, along with a special performance from our very own Senior Classes.

For those interested in attending the Ohana Day celebration, you must RSVP by Wednesday, October 1, or until full whichever comes first. To RSVP, call the Hercules Senior Center at 510-799-8219. Tickets are \$6 for Hercules Senior Center Members, and \$10 for non-members.

BAY FRONT FESTIVAL AND RUN

The Bay Front Festival and Run are coming up fast. Both events will be held at the Bay Front on Sunday, October 19. The day starts off with the Run; featuring a 5K, 10K, and a Kids Fun Run. The Bay Front Festival is the party that follows the run. There will be music, vendors, food trucks, and local entertainment. The festival is Sunday, October 19, from 11a-3p. Come for the run, but stay for the fun! The Bay Front Festival and Run never disappoint!

UNITY DAY

October is National Bullying Prevention Month in the U.S. Typically a very special event is held on the third Wednesday in October, however in 2025 it will be on the fourth Wednesday in October, and this event is known as **Unity Day**. This year it will be celebrated on **Wednesday**, *October 22. Unity Day is the signature event of National Bullying Prevention Month. The key message of this month, and this day, is to unite for kindness, acceptance, and inclusion, to prevent students from being bullied.

HOW TO CELEBRATE UNITY DAY

- 1. Take a pledge against bullying: https://www.pacer.org/bullying/pledge/
- 2. Share your tale about bullying. Let others know what happened, how it impacted you.
- 3. Wear orange: The color Orange is described as warm and inviting, as well as being commonly associated with safety, visibility, and protection.
- 4. Promote the message "Together against bullying. United for kindness, acceptance, and inclusion."

Unfortunately, more than one out of every five students will be bullied this year. This is probably happening to someone you know and care about.

Car/Trunk participants decorate their vehicles and fill their trunks with candy, while children in costumes (along with their familes) will stroll from car to car looking at all the decorated vehicles and collecting candy.

Prizes will be awarded to the top three votes for best decorated car trunks..

- 1st place is the "Best In Show", and will be awarded the **Fab-BOO-lous** distinction.
- 2nd place receives the **SPOOK-Tacular** award. And
- 3rd place recieves the famed **CASPER-esque** award.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Most of the costs for these events are covered in donations, or within the cost of other programs. The Bay Front Run and Festival is a city co-sponsored event, that is run by the Bayfront Chamber. The biggest cost of Trunk or Treat is candy, and many of the City recognized groups enter at least one vehicle and/or donate lots of candy for the games and to ensure we don't run out during the event. The biggest cost of PUMPKATAAZ are pumpkins that we purchase for our in-house program like preschool and afterschool. However, these programs, would be making the purchase of pumpkins for craft projects anyway, so the cost is already accounted for.

Parks and Recreation feels fortunate not to have a need to purchase decorations, because of past Halloween programs there is a plethora to choose from. In addition, both preschool and after school programs create lots of decorations that can be incorporated into the events décor.
