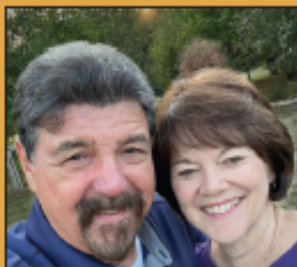
COMMUNITY MEMBER AWARD: The nominee must be...
