

AMENDMENT NO. 7

1. Parties. The parties to this Contract Amendment are the City of Hercules, a public body corporate and the following named Contractor:

The parties to this Contract Amendment do mutually agree and promise as follows:

2. Purpose. This Amendment No. 7 is being entered into to amend an existing contract between the City and Contractor which was approved by the City Council of the City of Hercules on December 20, 2011 by Resolution No. 11-145. Said contract shall hereinafter be referred to as the "Original Contract" and is incorporated herein by reference.

3. Original Contract Provisions. The parties hereto agree to continue to abide by those terms and conditions of the Original Contract, and any amendments thereto, which are unaffected by this Contract Amendment Agreement.

4. Amendment. This Amendment No. 7 is intended to amend the Original Contract and previously approved amendments (collectively, the "Amended Contract") thereto to provide on-call project support services for the Regional Intermodal Transportation Center in Hercules through June 2018 for additional compensation in an amount not to exceed \$60,500, total contract amount \$821,500.
