RESOLUTION NO. 18-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERCULES AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH AIMS COMPANIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$631,000 FOR THE GRAVITY SEWER CLEANING AND INSPECTION PROJECT, AND AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE OF UP TO \$63,100 FOR A 10% CONTINGENCY ON SAID CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Gravity Sewer Cleaning and Inspection Project was advertised for bids in the West County Times on January 9 & 16, 2018 and in 4 regional plan rooms; and

WHEREAS, a total of 5 bids were received at the bid opening deadline of 2 pm on Tuesday, January 30 and upon opening and reviewing the 5 bids received, Aims Companies submitted the low bid in the amount of \$\$631,000; and

WHEREAS, Aims Companies has been determined to be a responsible bidder and their bid has been determined to be responsive; and

WHEREAS, the contract is fully funded with Sewer Funds included in the Adopted FY 1718 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the work involved is a good standard of practice, will ensure the sewer collection system functions properly, and is required by the Hercules Sanitary Sewer Management Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hercules that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with Aims Companies in the amount of \$631,000 for the Gravity Sewer Cleaning and Inspection Project, and authorizing an additional expenditure of up to \$63,100 for a 10% contingency on said construction contract
