

RESOLUTION NO. 18-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERCULES AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH TELFER PAVEMENT TECHNOLOGIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$967,624 FOR THE 2018 PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE PROJECT, AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE OF UP TO \$96,762 FOR A 10% CONTINGENCY ON SAID CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT, AND APPROPRIATING \$150,000 FROM THE GAS TAX FUND TO FULLY FUND SAID CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the 2018 Pavement Maintenance Project was advertised for bids in the West County Times on July 2 & 9, 2018 and in 4 regional plan rooms; and

WHEREAS, a total of 2 bids were received at the bid opening deadline of 2 pm on Tuesday, July 25 and upon opening and reviewing the 2 bids received, Telfer Pavement Technologies submitted the low bid in the amount of \$967,624; and

WHEREAS, Telfer Pavement Technologies has been determined to be a responsible bidder and their bid has been determined to be responsive; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient cash funding in the Gas Tax Fund to appropriate \$150,000 to fully fund the construction contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hercules that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Telfer Pavement Technologies in the amount of \$967,624 for the 2018 Pavement Maintenance Project and authorizing an additional expenditure of up to \$96,762 for a 10% contingency on said construction contract, and to appropriate \$150,000 from the Gas Tax Fund to fully fund said construction contract.
