SUBJECT:	Acceptance of the Duck Pond Park Improvement Project, Appropriating \$3,119 in Parks & Recreation Development Impact Fee Funds to Fully Fund the Project, and Authorizing the Filing of the Notice of Completion

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Adopt a resolution accepting the Duck Pond Park Improvement Project construction contract with HM Construction as complete for a total amount of \$153,462, appropriating \$3,119 in Parks & Recreation Development Impact Fee Funds to fully fund the project, and authorizing the filing of the Notice of Completion with the Contra Costa County Recorder's Office.

FISCAL IMPACT OF RECOMMENDATION:

The final proposed budget for the Duck Pond Park Improvement Project is as follows:

The construction contract with HM Construction was completed at the budgeted 10% contingency; however, now that the final project costs are known an appropriation of \$3,119 in Parks & Recreation Development Impact Fee funds is needed to fully fund the project including costs associated with the restroom acquisition and project design.

DISCUSSION:

This project constructed a reduced-sized, asphalt (i.e. blacktop) half basketball court including striping, concrete walkways (i.e. sidewalk), a player's bench, ornamental fence to intercept any balls, and landscaping modifications. The project also installed a prefabricated, two room restroom, which was purchased separately from the manufacturer CXT and delivered on site.

The project was constructed by HM Construction, who was the low bidder. They are located in Hercules and have been in business for 23 years. Filing the Notice of Completion will allow the final retention payment to be made to HM Construction.
