

RESOLUTION NO. 19-

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERCULES
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION
CONTRACT WITH CHRISP COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$83,030 FOR THE
HERCULES AVENUE TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT**

WHEREAS, following the conceptual approval of the Hercules Traffic Calming Plan at the October 23, 2018 Council Meeting, the final plans were completed and 3 bids were solicited using the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act; and

WHEREAS, one bid was received from the Chrisp Company in the amount of \$83,030; and

WHEREAS, the Chrisp Company has successfully completed many projects in the Bay Area where the construction industry is booming and there is a labor shortage; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient funding for this work from the General Fund Budget Referral 19-17 Traffic Calming and from the Gas Tax/Measure J FY 18-19 Restriping Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hercules that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Chrisp Company in the amount of \$83,030 for the Hercules Avenue Traffic Calming Project.
