RESOLUTION NO. 20-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERCULES AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR EXEMPTION FROM THE LOCAL BICYCLE ADVISORY COMMITTEE (BAC)/ BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE (BPAC) REQUIREMENT AND DESIGNATING THE CONTRA COSTA COUNTYWIDE BAC AS THE REVIEW BODY FOR TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT ARTICLE 3 PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE FUNDING IN THE CITY OF HERCULES.

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is responsible for establishing policies and procedures for Transportation Development Act Article 3 Pedestrian and Bicycle (TDA 3) grant funding; and

WHEREAS, in June 2013, the MTC updated TDA 3 policies by adopting Resolution 4108 which requires each jurisdiction to have a local Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC)/Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) to review and prioritize TDA Article 3 bicycle and pedestrian projects and to participate in the development and review of comprehensive bicycle plans; and

WHEREAS, MTC guidance allows a local agency to apply for an exemption from using a local BAC/BPAC if it can demonstrate that the countywide BAC/BPAC provides for expanded city representation; and

WHEREAS, each member of the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors has appointed a representative on the Contra Costa Countywide BAC; and

WHEREAS, said representation for each Supervisorial District in turn represents the local agencies within each District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hercules that:

- 1. The Contra Costa Countywide BAC provides for expanded city representation in the City of Hercules.
- 2. The City of Hercules hereby directs the City Manager or designee to apply to MTC for exemption from the city BAC/BPAC requirement.
- 3. The City of Hercules hereby identifies the Contra Costa Countywide BAC as the review body for Transportation Development Act Article 3 Funding of pedestrian and bicycle projects in the City of Hercules.
- 4. The City of Hercules hereby identifies the County Supervisorial District 5 representative on the Contra Costa Countywide BAC as the City of Hercules representative on said committee.
